THE STAGES THAT COME BEFORE

PHONICS



WORD AWARENESS

An awareness that speech is made up of words!



RHYME AWARENESS

An understanding that words rhyme when the ending sound is the same.



SYLLABLE AWARENESS

The ability to hear that words are made up of syllables. E.g 'tea/cher' is 2 syllables



ONSET + RIME

Words can be broken up into onset-beginning sound, and rime the remaining vowel sound and final consonants.

and MANIPULATE
phonemes (the
smallest units of
sound).
e.g. 'cat' is made
up of /c/ /a/ /t/



The connection of sounds to written letters and written letters to sounds.
